FINANCIAL AND FISCAL COMMISSION RESPONSE TO THE ALLEGATIONS OF SEXUAL HARASSMENT

The Financial and Fiscal Commission has become aware of the allegations of sexual harassment against interns in 2021 that have appeared in the media. The Commission considers the allegations serious in nature and assures its stakeholders that the matter is receiving the highest attention. All stakeholders including employees have the right to be accorded respect and treated with dignity and to work in an environment that is free of harassment or misconduct of whatever form. A full and independent investigation of what transpired and how it was handled will ensue. This will be closely monitored by the Commission and concluded as speedily as possible.

The Commission has reached out to its staff to come forward and report any forms of sexual harassment in the workplace during any period.

The Commission will also ensure that the rights and dignity of all affected parties are safeguarded throughout this process.
